Since the inauguration of the Liver Transplant Program at KAMC in 1994 it is expanding constantly. Its active staff and cases being treated are in a constant increase. It has expanded to include the surgical operations and necessary interferences for liver, gallbladder, pancreatic diseases. Such increasing activities necessitated the establishment of a new Center to satisfy the program's expansion and the pressure from all facilities Kingdom wide. In 2001 Hepatobiliary Sciences & Liver Transplant was transferred to its new Center.

Services provided by the center

The Center comprises an admission suite for investigation, treatment and surgical operations for liver cases, e.g. tumor excision and liver transplantation. It comprises out-patient clinics with its ancillary services in which the referred patients are screened and followed up. The Center receives hundreds of medical reports for review and provides consultation either to the patients or the referring centers Kingdom wide. Therefore, the Center is serving the Kingdom as being a main center for treating liver diseases, as it comprises qualified staff in the different fields related to adult and pediatric hepatology, including liver transplantation and Pancreatic and Hepatobiliary surgeries.

The Center developed many important programs e.g. liver transplant program through brain-death donors, or partial-liver

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Organ donation is permissible in Islamic law and such procedure, God willing, will save a life threatened by death due to organ failure. The rate of success of the donation is more than 99%, God willing. The donation is considered a new life grant by God's will to someone else on the verge of death because of your generous donation. Such deed is considered an ongoing charity and so you benefit others and benefit from this donation without any harm to you, God willing.

Shari'a Fatwa:

Decision of the Council of Senior Scholars:

The Council has decided that it is permissible to transfer an organ or a part of it from a living Muslim or non-Muslim to a Muslim who is in need to it, provided no danger will harm him/her in the removal procedure and the transplant will most likely succeed. Also, the majority of the Council decides the following:

- It is permissible to transfer an organ or a part of it from a dead person to a Muslim if he/she is in need to it, it is safe to remove it from the donor, and the procedure will be most likely successful.
- It is permissible for a living person to transfer an organ of him/her or part of it to a Muslim who is in need to it.

Conditions of Donation:

- The donor must be 18 to 50 years old.
- Non obese (based on height with weight).
- The donor must be an adult, willing to donate and have no benefit of any kind from such donation.
- Donor blood type should be compatible and similar to the blood type of the recipient.

3) GETTING STARTED

To be able to submit a request to the **Donation of liver and kidney**, you need to fill the fields

1. Donor ID/Iqama: write your national Id or Iqama number
2. Donor Name: write your name
3. Donor weight: write your weight
4. Donor height: write you height
5. Donor mobile No: write your phone number
6. Donor Blood Type: choose your blood type
7. Limb: choose the limb you want to donate.
8. Nationality: choose your nationality
9. Donor Date of Birth: enter your birth day (your age should be between 18-50 or you will your be able to processed) Type Above Shown below: for security reason write the same letters you see in the picture.
10. Type Above Shown below: for security reason write the same letters you see in the picture.
11. Then click Submit.
12. If you did not fill all the required fields then you will not be able to submit your request
13. After submitting satisfaction survey will appear.
14. After filling the fields click on submit button
