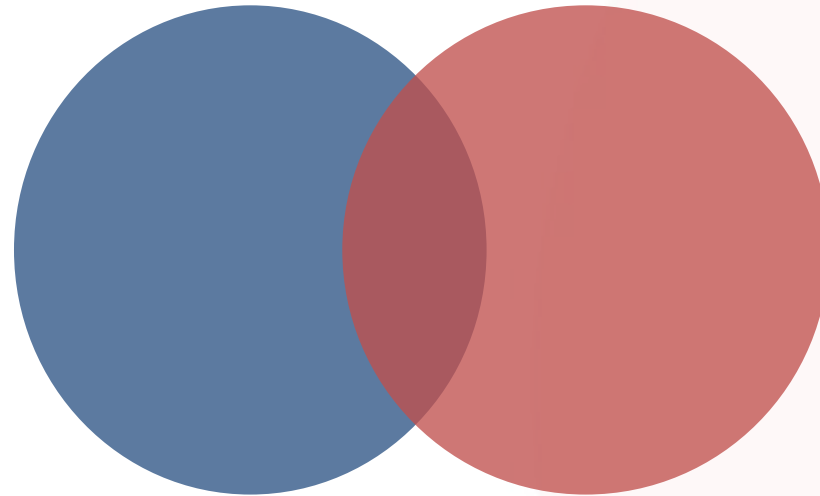

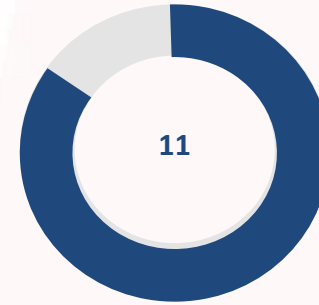

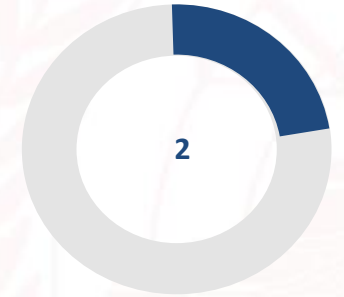

Based on the results of the consultation, A sign language translation service has been added to the website to enable MNGHA's visitors who are deaf or have a hearing impairment to benefit from the virtual sign language interpreter service, which translates the written content into sign language. In addition accessibility tools which provide features help the visually impaired and people who suffer from dyslexia , color blindness , epileptic seizures , Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD) , and limited movement , so that it is easier for them to understand and interact with website also translation feature to enable users browse the website pages and translate the text into preferred language. 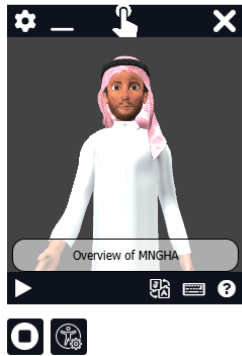

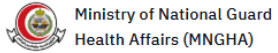
