Prevention Program

In National Guard Health affairs

School dental prevention Program considered to be one of the most significant leading programs in the field of health awareness and education for children. The main target of the program is to decrease the percentage of caries among students in National Guard Ministry by visiting them in schools.

The program begun on Tuesday 19 Jumada'l 1428 / June 5 ,2007 under the patronage of Royal Highness Prince Metub bin Abdul-Aziz the minister of National Guard , guiding all staff to give the best preventive and remedial services to the children of national guard ministry.

Program objectives

- Apply preventive treatment, awareness programs, and oral health education as saying prevention is better than cure therefore it is the significant key to reach high level of care in oral health.
- Proper application of preventive treatment and school dental prevention programs lead to decrease the percentage of dental cavities and caries, thus to reduce the financial costs of dental treatment and oral diseases.
- Apply healthy nutrition programs by rationalizing the consumption of sugar and the quality of food provided to children in schools and reducing sugars and sugar-sweetened beverages.
- The application of preventive procedures such as: applying fluoride, composites, and explaining brushing techniques.
- Early diagnosis and treatment of dental cavities and caries for permanent and milk teeth.
- Follow up to achieve continuity in applying of preventive programs.

Mobile Clinics of Dental oral health program

There are four well prepared mobile clinics, each one contain two well equipped clinics with latest materials, there are two dentist and their assistants beside the oral health specialists, in addition to Bader clinics in the housing of king Abdul-Aziz medical city that receive difficult cases for comprehensive dental care that cannot be treated in mobile clinics.



Program Achievements

The program visits start on Safer 16, 1429 H which correspond February 23, 2008, in Georgian and through several phases starting with screening, miner dental treatment, and then provide necessary treatment for students by fluoride application, permanent and preventive fillings in the mobile clinics. The program continues its mission in providing preventive and curative services; therefore the treated patients were nearly 19406 students since
