


Results of consultation on Measuring the suitability of a website for use by elderly


The Target

Results and impact



This enhancement aims to improve ease of access for individuals with disabilities and elderly, offering them a more comfortable, seamless, and inclusive user experience. This tool includes several key features, such a:

- Sign Language
- Screen Reader
- Bigger Text
- Word Spacing
- Pause Animation

Development is currently in progress to enhance virtual sign language, the virtual interpreter, and accessibility tools by adding features that comply with international accessibility standards.



Implementing Larger text features by clicking on "Bigger Text"


